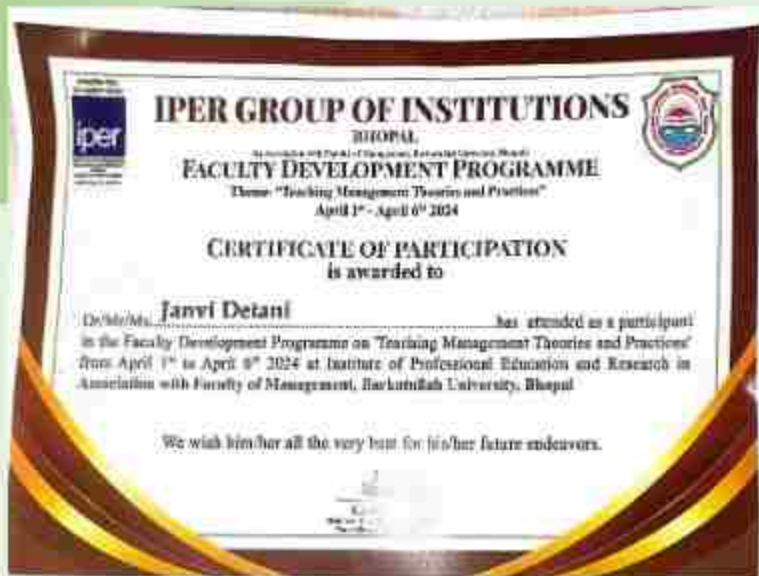

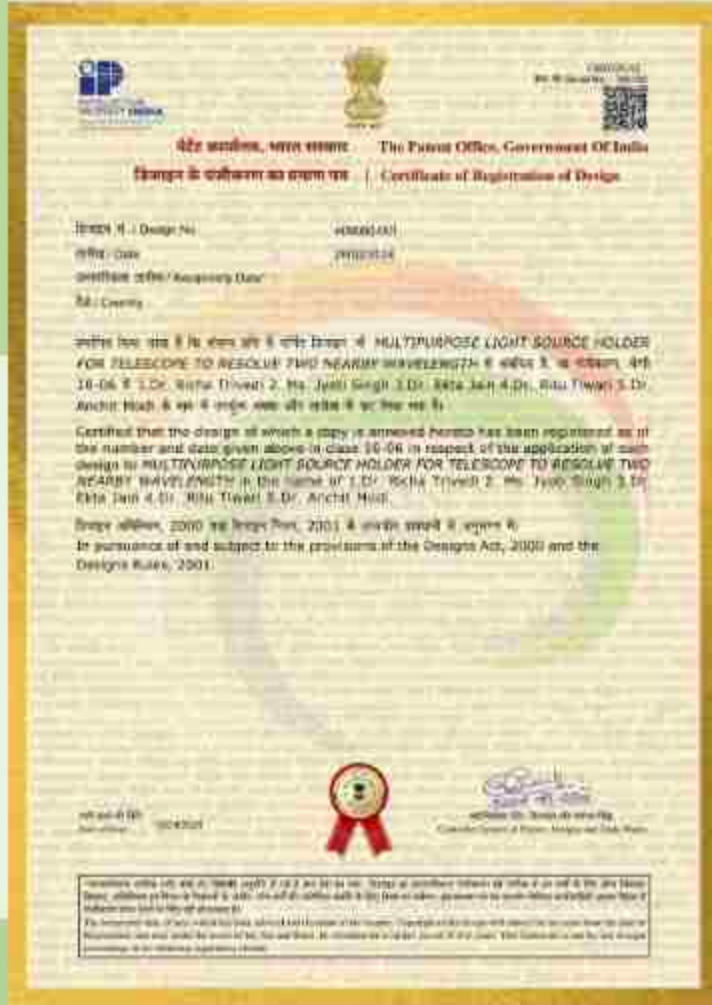

## Faculty Achievement: Patent Granted

On April 19, 2024, Professor Jyoti Singh, Head of the Department of Physics, achieved a significant milestone with the publication of the patent design for the "Multipurpose Light Source Holder for Telescope to Resolve Two nearby Wavelengths" by the Government of India under Design No. 409080-001. This innovative holder revolutionizes the way light sources are utilized in telescope experiments. Crafted with precision, the multipurpose light source holder ingeniously maximizes the utilization of space by incorporating slit-like openings on all four sides of the wooden or metallic box. Its top is detachable, featuring a secure holder for mounting sources like sodium lamps, ensuring stability and ease of use. The versatility of this holder is unparalleled. By employing slits of varying widths and inter-spacing, researchers can conduct a myriad of experiments with a single light source. The tray-type structure, easily attachable to the slit holders on all sides of the box, facilitates swift adjustments and experimentation. Cost-effectiveness is a hallmark of this design. Unlike traditional setups where slits are manually affixed to wood or glass mounts, the multipurpose light source holder streamlines the process, saving both time and resources. Its user-friendly nature allows for seamless experimentation, whether it's direct observation with a spectrometer or collaborative analysis of resolving power with multiple slit configurations. In essence, Professor Singh's invention represents a leap forward in experimental physics, providing researchers with a versatile, efficient, and cost-effective tool.

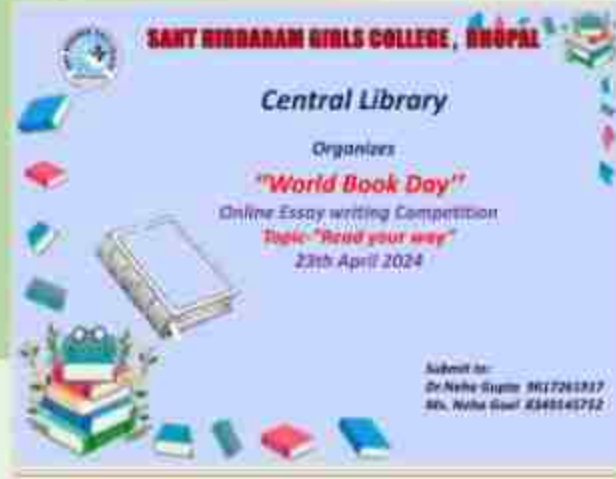
## Student Ayushi Makhija Triumphs at Prabhotsav: A Spectacle of Talent and Achievement

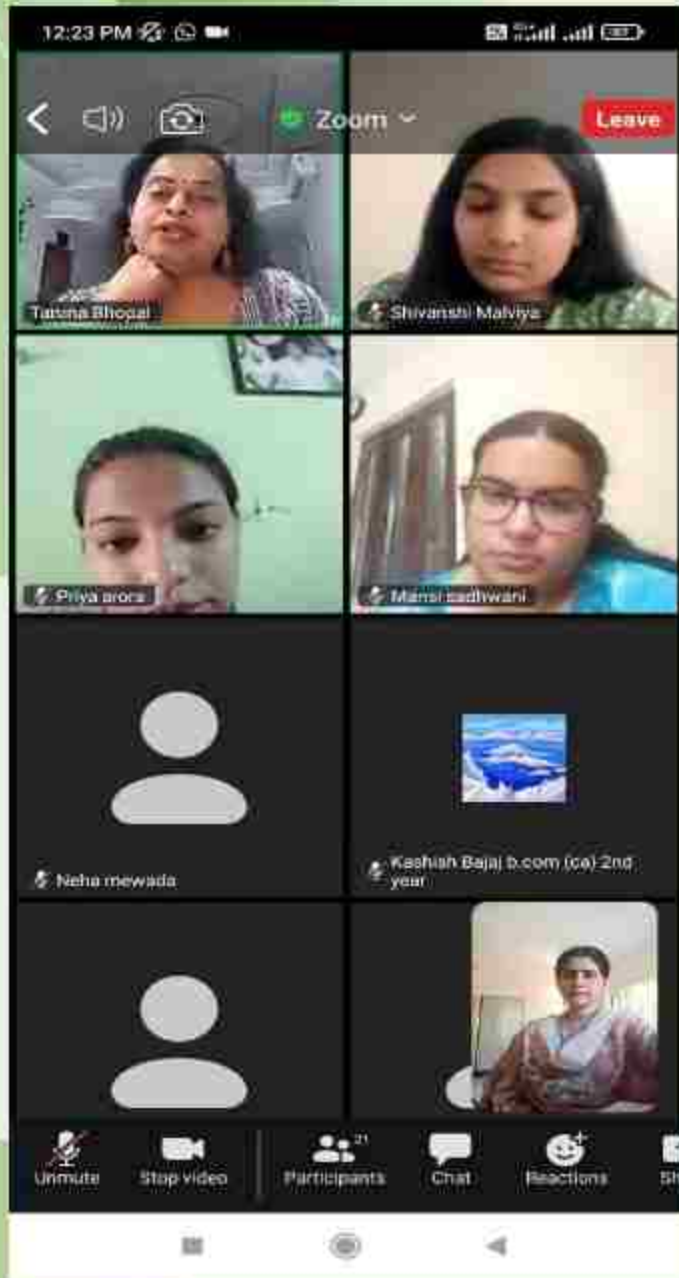
