## SHGC successfully concludes Campus Drive with Sciative Solutions and Tata Consultancy Services



## Dr. Neha Gupta Releases her Ninth Book on Arnold Wesker as a Playwright






## Empowering Futures: SHGC's Admission Initiatives and Career Guidance
