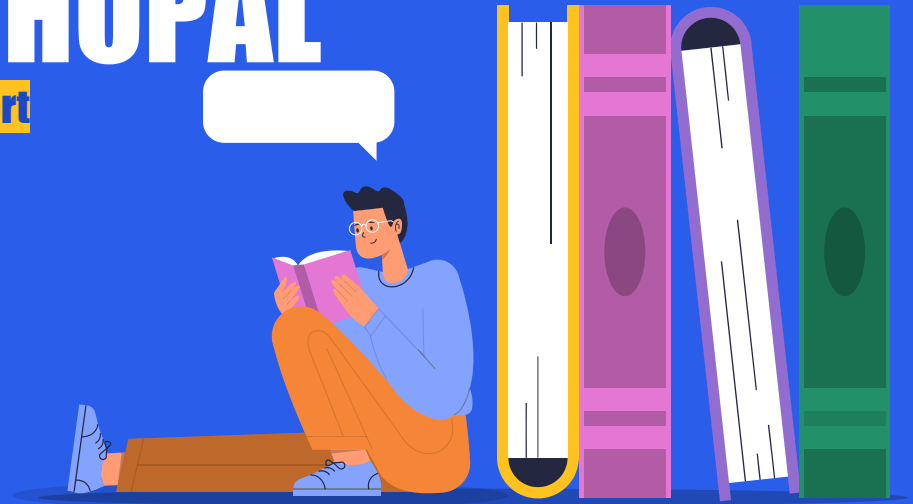

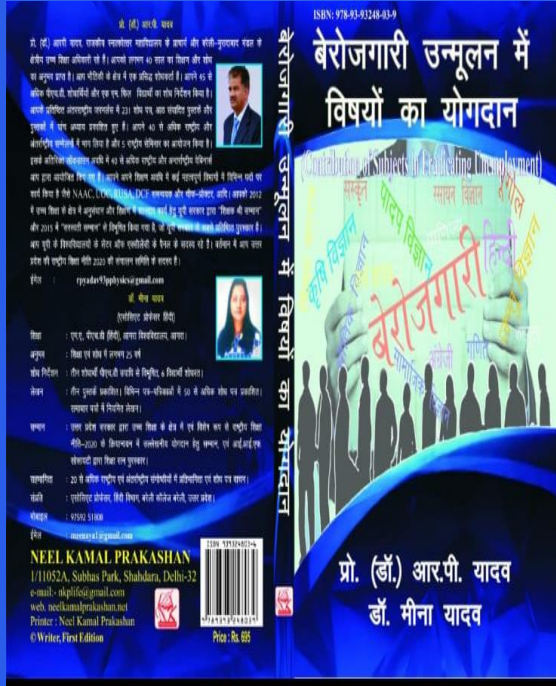
The students of all the three institutions shared their life experiences and feelings of gratitude towards teachers.

## Quiz on Entrepreneurship Development organized by E-Cell and Incubation Center of SHGC

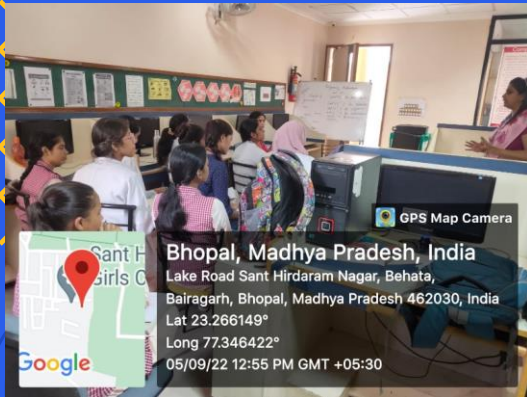
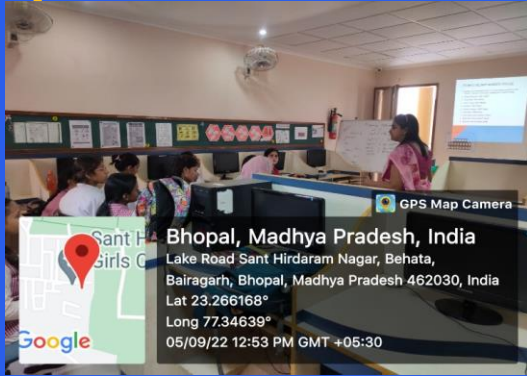

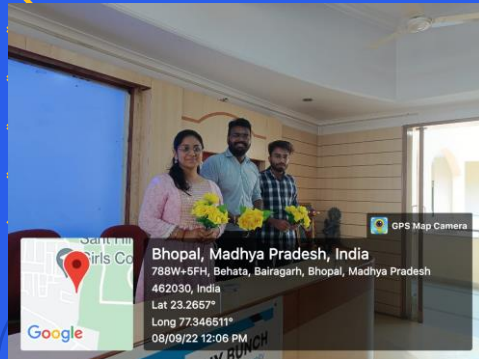

## Guest Lecture Organized by Department of Biotechnology

On 19<sup>th</sup> September, 2022, Monday Department of Biotechnology organized a Guest Lecture for all life science students on the topic **Role of Biotechnology in Agriculture**. The aim of organizing this lecture was to understand the different aspects and how new technology can change the face of agriculture. The Guest Speaker was **Dr Reena Mehra**, National Associate Scientist in Lentil in the South Asia & China Program at International Centre for agricultural research in the dry areas (ICARDA), Bhopal Division (M.P.).

The subject expert gave introduction about the ICARDA, its headquarters and research divisions in Madhya Pradesh and Bhopal. Dr Reena Mehra told about the varieties of pulses released using ICARDA germplasm in India. The traits of different pulses they are working on like to develop disease free, drought resistant, pesticide and herbicide resistant crops, having extra-large seeds with early maturity, high nutrition content and can be harvested easily by machines. She said that it's a need of the hour to work on these characteristics to overcome scarcity of food worldwide. She elaborated that the biotechnologist can play a very important role in the improvement of crops and the production of transgenic plants using techniques of genetic engineering, plant tissue culture, molecular biology etc. The role of microbiologist in pathological testing of crops was also conversed. She also informed students about the various fellowship programs in higher education in India and abroad. Scopes of biotechnology and job opportunities in the field of life sciences, in particular biotechnology were also discussed.

Dr. Chandra Paliwal, Incharge Principal and Dean Faculty of Science in her welcome address said that such lectures are benefiting for the students as they can learn about the applicability of the subject which they are studying in Industries.

A total of 52 students attended the program. Overall, the session was very enriching for the students and the queries of the students were also resolved.

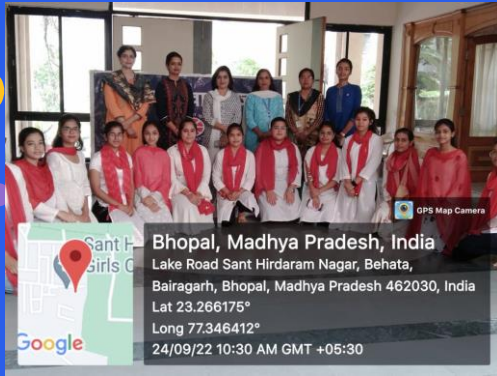
## NSS Day Celebrated at SHGC

## SHGC Educational Visit to Pathkind Laboratory, Bhopal

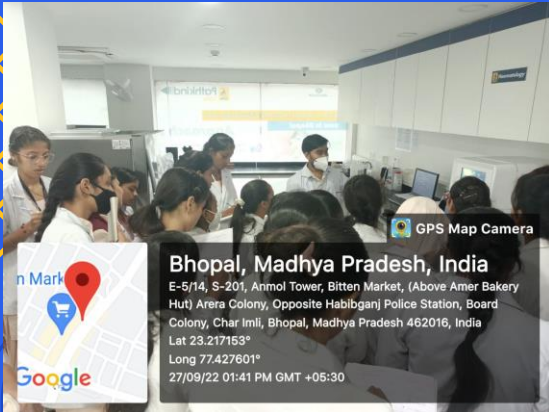
Wednesday, 28.09.2022 One day educational visit cum workshop was organized by Department of Biotechnology, Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal for UG & PG students dated 28<sup>th</sup> Sep 2022. 25 students along with one faculty Dr Manpreet Kaur started the visit at about 11:30 am for Pathkind lab, Bittan market, Bhopal. The entire visit was coordinated by Mr Saurabh Singh marketing executive, Pathkind lab.

Mr. Abhimanyu Singh, marketing head gave the brief introduction of the lab and introduced the scientific officers Vijay Kajwe and Gulshan Sauskar. The students were divided into batches. The first batch consists of UG students of B.Sc. II and III-year Biotechnology. They were briefly explained about the different steps needed while withdraw blood from patients. They explained the steps of barcode as well as how sample are labeled.

The senior scientific officers performed the VDRL and WIDAL test by using kit TYDAL WIDAL antigens for slide and test tube tests and TREPOLIPIN modified VDRL reagents. He explained clearly all the steps involved for the same.

They demonstrated the working of auto analyzer automated machine which helps in getting complete blood cell counts (CBC). Sophisticated analyzers measures cell morphology and can detect small cell population to diagnose rare blood conditions. They also demonstrated the working of automated biochemistry analyzer which is used to measure TSH, T3 T4, Blood sugar, HBA1C, LFT and KFT. Hormone analyzer, fully automated machine in which serum is loaded and all the parameters are analyzed by the machine.

The student performed the steps of venipuncture blood collection on Dumi arm. They also told how blood is collected at various places like home, office and in day care hospitals and how concerned person bring all the samples under strict environmental to lab for further processing. The lecture was quite interactive and brain storming.
