## **Chartered Accountant Examination May-June, 2024**

The CA examinations have been commencing successfully in our institution since last couple of years. The observers, special observers and even the candidates appearing for the exam appreciated the working culture of the College. Looking to the performance of SHGC Exam functionaries this year also, our institution had been earmarked to conduct CA Examination from 2nd May 2024 to 17th May 2024 & Foundation Exams from 20th June, 2024 to 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

ICAI exam, also known as the CA exam, is conducted by the <u>Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI)</u> for aspirants of <u>Chartered Accountancy</u> profession in India. The exam is conducted at three different levels as per the CA courses. For being certified as a Chartered Accountant, candidates have to clear all the course levels.

The exam comprises of following papers:

- CA Foundation course examination (four papers)
- CA Intermediate examination (eight papers)
- CA Final examination (eight papers)

Foundation, Intermediate and Final CA Examination May-June 2024, has been conducted smoothly at Sant Hirdaram Girls College, Bhopal. The exam included MCQ's as well as descriptive type questions. The question papers were kept in the safe custody of Bank of Baroda, Malviya Nager, Bhopal by ICAI. Every day on the date of Exam, as per the Code allotted, the question papers were distributed to the respective examination centres in the presence of Observers appointed by ICAI and Chief Invigilator of the institution. Dr. Suneela Choube, Asst. Prof. & HOD, Education has been assigned as Chief Invigilator under the supervision and guidance of the Principal, Dr. Dalima Parwani. Every day, full time Observers were deputed by ICAI to monitor the vigilance of the exam. All the teaching and non- teaching Staff members worked effectively and efficiently in the overall interest of CA Student's community.
